Steps in the Grade Grievance Procedure

A student who dissutes an assignlegrade must follow the sted procedures in order.

The student must discuss topicevancewith the <u>faculty member</u> involved. Every effort should be made resolve the disagreement with the faculty member. The student may seek advice and counsel from the academic advisor or another faculty member about how to approach this discussion.

If no agreement can breached, the student must obtain the \$64& cademic GrievancePetition Formand, followingits instructions, file two copies of <u>written</u> <u>grievance</u>within 30 daysof thebeginningof the Fall or Winter term following the term in which the disputed grade was awarded.
